*A Fake Website is a website that is not a legitimate venue. For example, the site is designed to entice the visitor into revealing sensitive information, to download some form of malware, or commit fraudulent transactions.*

*Recently, First Choice Bank was made aware of a fake website using the Bank's name and logo and attempting to portray First Choice Bank as shown below:*
